Public Statement from the CCSAI Board of Directors

The CCSAI Board of Directors is providing an update regarding the anonymous email dated May 12, 2025, which raised allegations concerning CCSAI governance and leadership.

Upon receipt of the email, the Board initiated an independent investigation conducted by an external investigator to ensure that all concerns were reviewed fairly, impartially, and in accordance with CCSAI's governance standards.

The investigation included a comprehensive review of the allegations, relevant documentation, and applicable governance frameworks.

The investigation has now concluded. The independent investigator determined that the allegations contained in the May 12, 2025 email were unsubstantiated and false.

The Board has formally reviewed and accepted the investigator's report and confirms that this matter is now closed. No further action will be taken in relation to the allegations raised in that email.

The investigation also determined that no wrongdoing by former President Ajané Adams occurred. The Board acknowledges that processes of this nature can have personal and professional impacts and reaffirms its commitment to procedural fairness, accountability, and responsible governance.

The Board remains committed to good governance, transparency, and continuous improvement. Where governance processes can be strengthened, the Board will continue to address those matters through appropriate policy and oversight measures.
